Lesson 6a	What are you going to do during the summer break? What are you going to do during the summer break? Are you doing anything on Saturday? One Step Further: <i>Will you be busy/working on the weekend?</i>	Showing agreement
Lesson 7a	What did you do during the holidays? What did you do during the holidays? How was it? One Step Further: <i>Who did you go with? How long did you go there for?</i>	Giving general answers
Lesson 8a	Have you ever been to Hokkaido? Do you like to buy souvenirs when you travel? Have you ever been to Tokyo Disneyland/eaten snails/hitchhiked? One Step Further: <i>Where would you like to go on your next trip? Why's that?</i>	Showing that you are following what is being said
Lesson 9a	Would you like to get married someday? Would you like to get married someday? What's the best age to get married? One Step Further: <i>What do you think makes a good marriage? What do you think brings happiness?</i>	Giving a reason with your answer
Lesson 10a	Would you ever go on a blind date? Would you ever go on a blind date? What do you think of fortune telling/people who park in the street? One Step Further: <i>Would you mind it if someone copied your homework?</i>	Changing the subject
Lesson 11a	What was your favorite TV show when you were ten? What was your favorite TV show when you were ten years old? How have you changed since you were in high school? One Step Further: <i>What did you want to be when you were ten years old? Did you ever play hide-and-seek when you were younger?</i>	Maintaining eye contact
Lesson 12a	What would your dream job be? What would your dream job be? Can you drive a car? Are you good at serving customers? One Step Further: <i>What does being a teacher involve? What kind of people make good teachers?</i>	Not over-praising or being over-humble

What's the best way to get there? Where's the best place to eat out?</i>	Expressing that you haven't understood something <i>I don't know vs. I don't understand</i>
Lesson 4b	Talking about your schedule How many days off do you have a week? Do you think that's enough? One Step Further: <i>What's your favorite day of the week? What's your busiest day of the week? What do you wish you had more time to do?</i>	Responding to what someone has said
Lesson 5b	Talking about shopping Do you ever shop online? One Step Further: <i>What kinds of shops do you like browsing in? What kinds of things do you like looking at? How often do you shop for food?</i>	Asking personal questions
Lesson 6b	Talking about the near future What are your plans for the weekend? One Step Further: <i>Is there anything you are looking forward to in the near future? What's something you want to have done soon?</i>	Remembering that some nuances don't translate
Lesson 7b	Talking about weekends and holidays What do you/your friends/Australians usually do during the holidays? One Step Further: <i>What's your typical weekend like? What was the highlight of your holiday? Describe your ideal weekend.</i>	Distinguishing yourself from others
Lesson 8b	Talking about travel and experience What's the best place you have ever travelled to? One Step Further: <i>What's the best/worst thing about travelling? What do you miss most when you travel? Tell me about your strangest travel experience.</i>	Using tag questions to elicit responses
Lesson 9b	Talking about life plans Do you think it's OK to live together before getting married? One Step Further: <i>Do you believe that both parents should work? Why do you think it's important to live together before marriage?</i>	Disagreeing politely
Lesson 10b	Talking about your values and interests How important is it for you to be in fashion? How interested are you in politics? One Step Further: <i>What's the most important thing in your life? What's something you couldn't live without?</i>	Asking for clarification: <i>Do you mean...? What do you mean?</i>
